LIVING LAB – MANITOBA (LL-MB) IS A RESEARCH-BASED PROGRAM THAT COLLABORATES WITH AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS TO DEVELOP GRASSROOTS SOLUTIONS FOR REDUCING AGRICULTURAL IMPACTS ON CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENT.

LL-MB IS BUILT IN PARTNERSHIP WITH AND DELIVERED BY MANITOBA'S 14 WATERSHED DISTRICTS AND WAS DEVELOPED IN COLLABORATION WITH A HIGHLY ENGAGED NETWORK OF LOCAL AGRICULTURAL PRODUCERS, INDUSTRY GROUPS, INDIGENOUS GROUPS, AND NONPROFIT GROUPS.

FUNDED THROUGH AGRICULTURE & AGRI-FOOD CANADA, LL-MB IS A FIVE-YEAR PROJECT THAT AIMS TO SLASH GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS, ENHANCE CARBON SEQUESTRATION, AND PROTECT WATER THROUGH ENHANCED LAND MANAGEMENT AND INTEGRATED WATERSHED MANAGEMENT.

RESEARCH PROJECTS DONE ON LOCAL MANITOBA FARMS WILL INFORM THE DEVELOPMENT OF NEW AND INNOVATIVE AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES AND WILL PROVIDE A SOLID FOUNDATION FOR FURTHER POLICY PLANNING SURROUNDING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION.
